Training Report on Prevention, Mitigation, Preparedness, Response & early warning system to UDMC members and Community Volunteer's.

Introduction: Bangladesh is one of the most disaster prone countries in the world. Every year Bangladesh faces various disasters some of them are natural and some of them are anthropogenic of origin. Union Parishad is the lowest administrative unit of Bangladesh. There is a Disaster Management Committee (DMC) at the union level. But member of UDMC are not sufficiently capable to do their responsibilities properly during disaster period. So capacity building of those committees is very important at this moment. BLUE GOLD project has realized this situation and is trying to do different types of activities for capacity building of UDMC member's and Community volunteers. Training is a process of capacity building. Considering this matter Shushilan BLUE GOLD has arranged training on Disaster Prevention, Mitigation, Preparedness and Response and early warning system of the deluti union disaster management committee members and Community disaster volunteer. Disaster Risk reduction is in the main stream of Blue Gold program. It has been working for disaster risk reduction through capacity building of UDMC and community DRR

Volunteers of WMG in each polder. **Babu Samar Kanti Halder**-UP Chairman and Chair of the Deluti Union Disaster management Committee-UDMC was presided over the training opening ceremony and also he inaugurated that program. Welcome speech was given by **Dr. Kabil Hosen-Environmental and DRR Expert**, Blue Gold project, Paikegacha, Khulna, also he described on Blue Gold DRR activities in details, General speech was given by **Kartick Chanadra Biswas–Coordinator-DRM** on behalf of Shushilan training team, Khulna, and another important speech was given by WMG highlighted member **Babu Gurudas Roy**. The UP member Supada Roy & Ranadhir Mondol and DRM training Officer Tapash Kumar Roy, Shushilan, Khulna and others were present there. The inaugural session were presented by Sawapna Rani Nag- Asst. DRM Training officer, Shushilan, Khulna.

Date of Training: On February 7-8 and 19-20, 2015 training was held on Prevention, Mitigation, Preparedness and Response & early warning system.

Time: It was two day long training. The training started at 9.30 am and closed at 5.30 pm in each day. A few numbers of participants attended course after started.

Venue: The training was held at Deluti Union parishad Hall Room, Paikgacha, Khulna. UDMC Chairperson and member secretary confirmed the training venue from UP.

Facilitator: Blue Gold program Shushilan Khulna has a small training team. The training team member was Kartick Chandra Biswas –Coordinator-DRM, Tapash Kumar Roy- DRM Training Officer and Sawpna Rani Nag - Asst. DRM Training Officer. So, Shushilan training team has conducted training courses as facilitator.

Monitoring and Supervision from the Blue Gold: On behalf of blue gold Dr. Kabil Hossain –Environmental & DRR expert monitored and supervised the training Program. He also provided good coordination and support for the course.

Objectives of the Training:

- To increase knowledge of UDMC members and Community disaster volunteers (WMG&WMA) on disaster risk reduction and disaster response.
- To increase knowledge of UDMC members and community disaster volunteers to concept on Disaster, Hazard, Risk, Disaster prevention, mitigation, preparedness and response and its effects.
- To explain the role of UDMCs members and volunteers regarding climate change and risk reduction.
- To increase knowledge and skills of UDMC members and volunteers on local level risk and risk reduction activities determination.
- Experience sharing among facilitator and UDMC Members.
- Implement and functioning of Govt. early warning system.

Main Content of Training:

First day: (Content)

Pre-training Activities: Inauguration, Training objective sharing, Introducing & Ice-breaking, Overview of Blue Gold Project, Pre-test, Training expectation & Principle, Team formation and responsibility distribution

Volunteerism in Disaster Management: Concept of Volunteerism, Humanity and Volunteerism, Principles of Volunteers & Examples of Volunteerism in Disaster Management

Basic Terminologies on Disaster Management: Concept of Cyclone and Tidal surge; Causes, effect & risk of cyclone & tidal surge; Cyclone & tidal surge prone areas

Roles to Risk Reduction: Pre, During & Post activities of cyclone and tidal surge

Basic concept: On Flood, storm surge, Water Logging, Salinity, Arsenic, River erosion, Drought, Cause & risk reduction strategies of Flood, Water Logging, Salinity & Arsenicosis

Cause & Climate change: (Concept of climate change, causes, relation with disaster, Impacts and adaptation) risk reduction strategies of Flood, Water Logging, and Salinity & Arsenicosis

Second day: (Content)

Early Warning System: (Cyclone signals, explanation of signals and roles based on govt. signaling system, Safe water, Sanitation and Personal hygiene in disaster, Roles and responsibilities of pregnant & lactating women, children, adolescents, aged people and disables in disaster risk reduction

Psycho-social care: Concept of psycho- social care primary

Coordination with UDMCs and CPP activities: Coordination with UDMC, CPP and Volunteers activities

Roles and Responsibilities: Roles and Responsibilities of Volunteers in Disaster Risk Reduction and Action Plan Preparation

Course Closing Activities: Review & Lesson learning, Training expectation fill up, Post Test, Evaluation and Feelings Sharing

Process of training arrangement:

After formation of training batch in each village of deluti union (22 no folder) under paikgacha upazila it was necessary to train up the concern UDMC (deluti) for increasing their knowledge and skills. As per decision of Blue gold DRR program authority Shushilan organized a two days long non residential training course of UDMC members and volunteers. The participants were invited by Chair of Deluty Union Disaster management Committee for joining at the two day long training program. They attended on the coursed at schedule date and time. Facilitators were displayed/demonstrated Prevention, Mitigation, Preparedness and Response and early warning system training related materials at the training session and explained. For well organization and smoothly facilitation training venue conformation, venue decoration, setting arrangement, Food and Snacks requisition were ensuring before one week.

Course Evaluation (pre-post test) and Participants comment:

As a part of training , the trainer was facilitated on pre & post assessment session to strating & ending time on training course on PMPR&EWS through written test. There were significant changed in each training participants or community volunteer of that test recorded. The pre assessment relult in avarage was **36%** and the post assessment was **93%**. So score has increased from pre-test to prost test was **57%** in avarage individually. There were mention that individual changed scored in an **enexure # 3**. Please see the attached file. The training was closed through formarly a small discussion session. A different level representative was participated on that discussion and they have given comment or oppinion on that training, At first they have a vote of thanks to shushilan for organized this kind of training organized. Babu **Nirod Chandra Mondol** -president of deluti Water Management Group-WMG, he commented that “ This kind of training were first & new in this area”. The training agenda was very subjective and relevent to present time like as- disaster termelogy(disasaster, risk, hazard, vulnerability), early warning system desiminate, cyclon signals and **pre-post & during** preparedness were very helpful for all Community peoples. We have followed it all the year round. Another hihglight person of WMG Vise president **Babu Gurudash Roy** said that” early warning materials was very important for cyclone signal desiminate “ he also proposed to **Blue Gold program**, they will be provided **EARLY WARNIGH MATARIALS** set to Volunteer Groups in deluty Union under paikegacha upazila for future action. AS a result all of training participants more satisfied for this kind of training could be receive. Again a vote of thanks to Shuhilan blue gold training program.

Challenges:

1. Lack of rapport building with Community Disaster Volunteers, WMG, WMA, UDMC members and others stake holders.
2. Timely ensuring participants at the venue.
3. To engage elected up members in a training session.
4. A little amount of money (100 BDT) as local transport or honorarium were given to each training Participants in day basis.
5. A huge number of participants in each batch (38 participants)

Learning's:

1. UP elected Chairman and members did not given sufficient time to receive training.
2. Most of the UDMC member has no basic knowledge about disaster in contest of Bangladesh. So they were showing interest in new issue.
3. Increase their eagerness to participate in disaster related training.

Recommendation:

1. Refresher training will be needed in appropriate time.
2. It should be arranged monthly or quarterly meeting with UDMC member and Community disaster Volunteers
3. Arrange more various disaster related training for UDMC like as- search and rescue, emergency leadership and Simulation
4. Arrange training outside of union parishad for better participation of UDMC members and volunteer for over motivation
5. Participants honorarium should be same as blue gold others training in daily basis.
6. It should be standard 20-25 members in each training batch

Conclusion:

These types of two days training will increase their knowledge on Prevention, Mitigation, Preparedness and Response and early warning system as recorded by pre and post test evaluation. The participants requested for more training on disaster management so that they can save their life and livelihoods through proper dissemination of warning message. The participants have been said in their post training comments. Now they are feeling very much courage to live in costal belt. This is great achievement for Blue Gold project
