| April | Summer <i>Grishsho</i> | | 14-Apr-19 | Kharif I | Pre-monsoon | The pre-monsoon season (March to May) has the highest temperatures and evapo-transpiration rates. Occasional squalls (nor-westers) give heavy rain showers with strong wind (and occasional hail and tornadoes). Tropical cyclones affect coastal areas in some years. |

| July | Monsoon <i>Borsha</i> | <i>Asharjh</i> | 16-Jul-19 | Kharif II | Monsoon | The monsoon season (June to September) has the highest rainfall, humidity and cloudiness. More than 80% of the annula rainfall usually occurs in this season. Totals vary greatly from year to year, and the start and end dates of the season can vary by a month or more between years. |
