Agreement Signing Ceremony on Operation & Maintenance

1. INTRODUCTION

On 17th October 2019 Blue Gold Program (BGP), Satkhira and BWDB O&M Division-2, Satkhira jointly organized the “Agreement Signing Ceremony on Operation, Repair & Maintenance in between WMAs and BWDB” at Shrimp Culture Demonstration Farm, Ellarchar under Sadar Upazila of Satkhira District. The objective of this program was to make both the parties (i.e. WMAs and BWDB) agreed on the roles & responsibilities on the overall Operation, Repair and Maintenance of Water Resource Management Infrastructures under Polder 2 and Extension Part, agreement signing & formally handing over the agreement documents to Water Management Associations (WMAs) by the BWDB O&M Division-2, Satkhira.

A total of 3 WMAs from the Polder 2 and Extension Part were attended in the program. The following table shows the details of WMA participants.

Mr. Mahfuz Ahmed, Chief Water Management, BWDB, Dhaka was attended as Chief Guest while Mr. Guy Jones, Team Leader, BGP; Mr. Md. Ayub Ali, PEO, BWDB, Kushtia; Agriculturist Md. Jashim Uddin, ADD (Crop), DAE, Satkhira; and Mr. Md. Hafizur Rahman, DCEO, BWDB, Jessore were present as Special Guests on the occasion of agreement signing ceremony. Mr. Md. Amzad Hossain, UAO, Sadar Upazila, Satkhira; Mr. Md. Earul Haque, UPIO, Satkhira; Officials from BWDB O&M Division-2, Satkhira; field level officials from DAE; journalists from print and electronic media; and Zonal Coordinators and seniors experts from BGP Dhaka, Khulna and Patuakhali were also present at the ceremony. In total, 58 participants were present in the program (participants list is attached in the Annex).

2. THE PROGRAM



The program was started at 10.00 AM through the recitation of Holy Quran by Blue Gold Civil Engineer Mohammad Shahidullah and Gita recitation by Polder Co-Coordinator Mr. Dino Bondhu Sarker. The program was continued up to 2.30 PM with the following key sessions:

1. O&M agreement signing, handing over and distribution among the WMAs and Photo Session
2. Distribution of WMAs registration certificates among WMAs by Chief Water Management of BWDB, Principal Extension Officer of BWDB, Executive Engineer of Satkhira O&M Division-2 and Team Leader of BGP.
3. Video show on news compilation on BGP activities which were published in different Television Channels, National News Papers and Local News Papers.
4. An attractive social drama named “we can” was staged which reflects the role of WMAs in building confidence on how to carry out the operation, repair and maintenance activities by the WMAs in improving water management, overcoming challenges, maximizing agricultural production and economic development.

Executive Engineer Mr. Arifuzzaman Khan, O&M Division-2, BWDB, Satkhira presided over the program. At the onset of ceremony Mr. Md. Hafizur Rahman, DCEO, BWDB, Jessore delivered the welcome speech. Mr. Joynal Abedin, Zonal Coordinator of BGP Satkhira clarified the importance of O&M Agreement in between WMAs & BWDB. He highlighted 4 objectives of the signing ceremony which includes:

i) Agreement signing in between WMAs & BWDB O&M Division-2, Satkhira and handing over the responsibilities;

ii) Sensitizing about the importance of proper water management, and operation and maintenance of infrastructure for maximizing benefit of crop cultivation;

iii) Sharing the responsibilities of BWDB & WMAs to address challenges as well as sustainable water management;

iv) Strengthening relationship among WMAs, BWDB, relevant GoB departments, private sector and NGOs for joint cooperation and partnership.



The Executive Engineer, O&M Division-2, BWDB, Satkhira and three President from three WMAs signed the O&M agreement. Later the WMA Registration Certificates were distributed to the three WMAs.

3. REMARKS & COMMENTS

Chief Water Management, BWDB, Dhaka

Mr. Mahfuz Ahamad, CWM, BWDB inaugurated the program and delivered his valuable comments on importance of integrated polder water management for livelihood improvement, completed and ongoing activities and impact of rehabilitation works in the polder. He pointed out towards the WMAs that they are life and heart of the party, center of attraction and most precious and prominent persons in this signing ceremony. He mentioned that BGP started the works here in 2014 and formed 3 WMAs (Amodkhali, SSM and Maheswarkati).



CWM demonstrated that 35.498 km resectioning of the embankment, 28.068 km khals re-excavation, 3 new sluices construction, 0.478 km low cost temporary protective works and 5 new box culverts construction have already been completed. In addition, 2 new sluices construction, 8 sluices repairing, 3 pump sheds construction works and 0.507km low cost temporary protective works are now running. He highlighted that different technologies have been adopted by BGP for increasing cropping intensity and crop production. Different collective actions: Poultry rearing, vegetables gardening and fish cultures are being done by improved/modern technology in the polder. As a result, livelihood standard of local people is being changed.

CWM also described the impact of rehabilitation works done by BGP in Polder 2:

- a) Water logging lands have brought under cultivation in 19 beels for over 16 years after re-excavation of Amodkhali Khal in 2017.
- b) Crop Production is increased in agricultural land under CAWM by BGP.
- c) Cultivation of HYV, Summer Tomato and Vegetables in the yard have increased by FFS training.

CWM Mr. Mahfuz Ahmed said that how development can be continued, how challenges can be mitigated- this should be found out. WMAs/WMGs are main responsible to find out the challenges. They are responsible for routine maintenance of water resource infrastructures. This is the main theme of the signing ceremony.

The CWM found that internal polder water management is getting importance through the works implemented by BGP for increasing cropping intensity and crop production. He described that 8 gated box culverts and 30m pucca drain construction and 21 field channels (length 10.10km) have been excavated under SSWMIs. Under CAWM 4 (Four) PVC Pipe Culverts for 4 WMGs, 1 Box Culvert with Fall Board, Installation of 2 PVC Pipes and 2 field channel (length 3.310) have been excavated in Polder

CWM mentioned that an Upazila Workshop was held on 1st October 2019 jointly organized by BWDB and WMAs in Satkhira Circuit House. Officials from BWDB, DAE, LGED, AC Land, UP, Upazila Parishad and District Administrative Officers were attended in that workshop. We expect that this workshop

will play a great role to get cooperation from GoB Organization and NGOs for participatory water management and small-scale project implementation. He added that BWDB and WMGs together will keep infrastructures functioning. Agreement will not be packed in a bag. BWDB, WMAs/WMGs will act as per agreement. Actually, WMAs are taking over responsibilities by today's agreement for sustainable water management.

Team Leader, Blue Gold Program

Blue Gold Team Leader Mr. Guy Jones was delighted to attend in the program, and welcomed extended by XEN

BWDB to Upazila officials from Satkhira Sadar and Assasuni Upazila. He also thanked especially to CWM, PEO & DCEO, BWDB and other officials from BWDB, Satkhira, 3 WMAs



those who signed O&M Agreements with BWDB and journalists from print and electronic media. He highlighted that Blue Gold Program started its journey to promote economic development through proper water management, modern agricultural practices and a focus on agriculture as a business with water management groups as the main driving force. Team Leader emphasized that coordination is the key to success. WMAs have to work through coordination with BWDB, BADC, DAE, Livestock and Fisheries. He also said that BWDB's responsibilities are: to work on water resource management activities but we have inspired and regenerated through the works done by WMAs/WMGs on internal polder water management, they have brought fallow land into Aman paddy cultivation. On 1st October 2019, an upazila workshop was organized jointly by WMAs and XEN, O&M Division-2 in Satkhira Circuit House to introduce WMAs with district and upazila staff to explain their roles to local government institutions. How government organizations may come forward in overcoming the conflicts and challenges which WMA face, how WMA will get cooperation from different organizations - this outline was discussed. We think that this workshop will open the door of partnerships development for WMAs with public/ private sector organizations. Team Leader also pleased to inform that a booklet on planning and implementation of polder water management for Polder 2, Satkhira was also provided to WMAs executive committee members and O&M sub-committees in the workshop. He requested them to read through the booklet for clear understanding of polder water management.



Team Leader also mentioned that O&M Agreements were signed with BWDB in Patuakhali (18 WMAs in 7 polders on 23rd January 2019) and Khulna (6 WMAs in 5 polders on 23rd September 2018) by BGP. Today a further 3 WMAs from Polder 2 and Extension Part entered into O&M Agreement with BWDB. These 3

WMAs together were representing 64 registered WMGs and over 19,000 WMGs members from eight

unions: 6 from Satkhira Sadar Upazila (Balli, Jhaudanga, Labsa, Brahmarajpur, Dhulihar, Fingri) and 2 from Assasuni Upazila (Kulla, Budhhata). Mr. Guy Jones commented that the O&M Agreements will set out the roles and responsibilities of WMAs and BWDB for routine, periodic and emergency maintenance of water management infrastructures. BGP TL remarked that the main objective of agreement is to sustain the benefits arising from bringing land into cultivation as well as to protect the land from waterlogging and to bring new land into cultivation. The new Water Rules 2018 provided such organizations with opportunities to be represented at union, upazila and district

level. We hope that the Rules can be modified to include WMGs/WMAs formed under the PWMR 2014. He emphasized that BGP is not end, further investments to work in water infrastructures are required in Satkhira. These will come through the Delta Plan: This delta plan will work as an umbrella- lot of works will be done through the delta plan. WMOs will work with government to shape and define future priorities for water management. Finally, Mr. Guy Jones told that we should work for re-excavating the Betna and Marichap River under delta plan.

Additional Deputy Director (Crop), DAE, Satkhira

Agriculturist Mr. Jashim Uddin, ADD (Crop), Satkhira highlighted the importance of polder water management for crop production. He said that another name of water is life. Water is the most vital element of plant and human life. Now a day's natural disaster flood, water logging and drought is the common phenomena in a



coastal belt due to climate change in Bangladesh. Unplanned shrimp cultivation, net parta's and cross bundh in the khals are creating water logging problem in the polder. BGP is actually working for sustainable water management. He said that local people could not cultivate Aman Paddy for long 16 years. After re-excavation of Amodkhali Khal by BGP, 19 beels in Polder 2 have brought under cultivation. This was the local people expectation. Now short-term basis varieties of Aman Paddy have come to our hand. These are the crops of 100 days. He said that FFS for providing technical knowledge and efficiency by BGP, which has played an important role in cultivation. BGP is also implementing CAWM at polder-2 and extension part. This is a new concept in BGP, where WMGs farmers came forward to increase agricultural production and income through improved internal water management, introduction of modern crop varieties and crop synchronization within sub-catchment areas. ADD (Crop) Mr. Jashim Uddin added that Vegetables cultivation in bags added a new dimension in BGP. Now WMAs should communicate with UP and DAE to increase agricultural production. 3rd World War may be only for water. We do not want 3rd World War. Not only in connection with crop field but also have to engage in poultry rearing and other agricultural production work for economic development.

XEN, O&M Division-2, BWDB, Satkhira

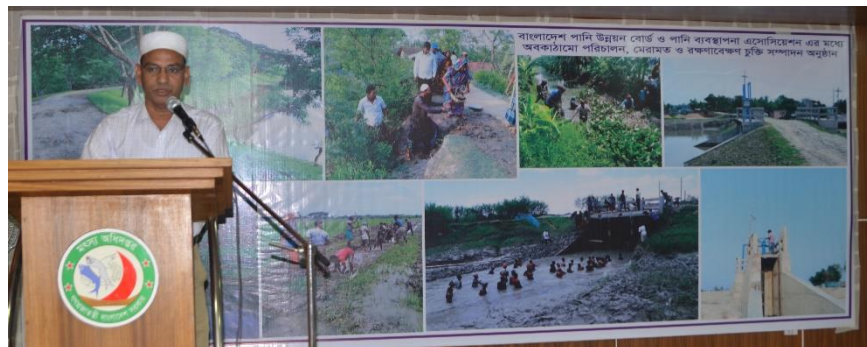


Executive Engineer Mr. Arifuzzaman Khan highlighted the responsibilities of WMAs and BWDB. He demonstrated the completed and ongoing works in Polder 2 and Extension Part. He said that Polder 2 was established in 1963. The Polder is a delta which is a basin of Padma, Meghna and Jamuna River. The delta is originated from

siltation of Padma, Meghna, Jamuna River which ultimately falls into the Bay of Bengal through the Meghna River. He mentioned that high tide and low tide is seen only 20% area of coastal belt in Bangladesh. Sediment is being deposited in the khals due to high tidal water and making infrastructures nonfunctioning. BGP is working to solve water related problems in Polder 2 and Extension Part. Lot of rehabilitation works have already been done by BGP. Actually, the BGP will be finished by June 2020. Therefore, there is a great responsibility in between WMAs and BWDB for operation, repair and maintenance of the infrastructures for sustainable water management.

Principal Extension Officer, PEO, BWDB, Kushtia

PEO Mr. Ayub Ali, BWDB, Kushtia welcomed all the participants. He remarked that BGP is a spiritual descendant of IPSWAM. It is envisaged that after completion of project, WMAs/WMGs are becoming inactive. How they will sustain- this is the



event of today. He added that there is conflict occasionally between shrimp cultivation farmers and farmers. They have to come in common interest for economic development in the polder. He emphasized that WMGs should call meeting regularly. Meeting resolution, income, expenditure and Audit should perform clearly. WMAs have to make good relationship personally and organizationally with UP, UPZ, Zila Parishad- if they communicate with the organizations to get cooperation, problems will be solved easily to inhibit saline water intrusion, illegal occupancy, construction/removal of cross bundh and other water related problems. PEO also mentioned that WMAs Registration was provided in this polder after becoming Self-sustainer and self-confident. For an example, if we attack by dengue fever, we should take treatment to live in this world. So, first WMAs have to become self-sustainer, self-service provider and self-confident for sustainable water management then registration. Actually, those who received registration, they obtained legal basement. Finally, PEO requested CWM, BWDB and Blue Gold TL to arrange a one-day workshop on “Which advantages and disadvantages WMAs got before or after getting registration”.

UP Chairman, Figri Union, Satkhira

After enjoying a heart attractive community drama ‘we can” Mr. Md. Shamsur Rahmam, Chairman, Fingri UP, Satkhira Sadar delivered that how he will proceed to take WMGs in the future- this is his dream for proper water management in the polder.



UP Chairman Mr. Shamsur Rahman added that how vegetables grow in the bags- BGP has trained and showed us practically. UP will play a significant role to work with WMAs/WMGs. He also emphasized their roles and

partnership relations with WMA and importance of O&M for water management infrastructures. How the Net Parta’s and illegal settlement can be removed- we should become active and hard working. If we work together, we will able to carry out the works as well as to overcome the challenges. Finally, he declared to continue UP support in implementing O&M actions plan as per the agreed sign.

WMA Representatives

WMA representatives shared the roles of WMA and challenges for implementation of O&M Activities and ways to overcome the challenges. Maheswarkati WMA President Mr. Bhubendra Sarkar expressed that WMG’s were formed in 2014. BGP will be memorable in our life as a lot of rehabilitation works done by BGP. Now we are committed to work as per agreement. He noticed that 5 culverts have been constructed by BGP in Maheswarkati WMA catchment area. He described that salt water is one side of Kolatola Box Culvert and the other side is sweet water. Instantaneously and spontaneously we constructed the cross bundh on the Surjokhali Khal by our own effort to inhibit saline water into sweet water of Himkhali Khal for aman paddy cultivation in adjacent land to the khal area. He also remarked that, 2 crops are being cultivated after constructing box culverts and excavation of field channels under SSWMIs. He is pleased to inform that water logging is also removed in Noikati Area due to excavation of field channels by BGP. Finally, he emphasized that we have insufficient O&M Fund, so fund collection from different source is required.



SSM WMA President Mr. Bayezid Bostami highlighted that BGP has a great contribution. Now no overtopping after re-sectioning of the embankment in the polder. He emphasized that unity is strength. We have to work together. If we want to die- we will die and want to live – we will live. We need to extend our hand to proceed in the future. Unity is a great strength- nobody can take over this strength. WMA General Secretary Mr. Sheikh Monayem also expressed that construction of sluices and box culverts, re-excavation of khals and resectioning of the embankment have been done by BGP but Betna /Marichap River is badly silted up, need to re-excavate for proper water management as water is not being drained out properly from some khals to the outlet. He commented that influential people/groups are installing net parta’s on the khals, leased out the khals- this should be completely stopped. We became self-dependent, self-confident by

agreement. Now we are committed to use the infrastructures properly. Mr. Sheikh Monayem also expressed that some local people are constructing households, shops and toilets on the slopes and crest of the embankment. As a result, embankment is damaging. Sluices are misusing by the influential. If we work together, nobody can misuse the sluices and other infrastructures. If net parta's are installed further on the khals, we will make a list to provide DC. He will take necessary steps to remove the obstacles. We got ownership through agreement signing. Now we must work together. SSM WMA General Secretary Mr. Abdul Wahab also mentioned that the reason for bad siltation of Betna River is Brick Field. Please save Betna River then we will save. He finally told that we got responsibility today- we will try to work sincerely but he drew attention to higher officials of BWDB to overcome the challenges.



Mst. Jahanara Khatun, Cashier, SSM WMA said that how BGP encouraged and supported women



members for their empowerment through engaging them in the economic development activities. BGP empowered us to work as a decision maker in the family. Mr. Mazed, Executive Member of Amodkhali WMA also shared that Amodkhali Sluice Catchment Area was flooded due to heavy rainfall on 14-20 August 2019. Transplanted Aman was submerged

under water. A meeting was called to reduce the flood water. WMA/WMG members attended in the meeting and agreed and worked continuously by 10 days, flood water reduced by our self-efforts spontaneously. Xen was present during drain out water through the Amodkhali Sluice. As a result, local people could transplant Aman again in this year.

4. DRAMA ON POLDER WATER MANAGEMENT

At the end of the agreement signing sessions, the participants had the opportunity to enjoy a socio-drama on "Amrai Pari" where this drama focused what are the possible challenges



and what are the ways to overcome those for effective polder water management. In the middle of the drama, the players were interacted with the audience and inspired the people to prevent those

sinister/harmful things & actors for effective water management. The drama was well played as a powerful tool to increase the motivation of the participants for protecting any unwanted situation against effective water management.

5. CLOSING SESSION

Mr. Arifuzzaman Khan, Exen, O&M Division-2, BWDB, Satkhira summarized the program and delivered valuable comments in his closing address. He commented on speech of UP Chairman/ Amodkhali WMA President Mr. Shamsur Rahman how he succeeded by self-services in the polder level. He is pleased to deliver that DC, Satkhira removed net parta's from some khals during his field visit. He expressed that how the Outfall Rivers (Betna and Marichap River) will be active, so program for Tk. 497 crore is already recommended by PM for re-excavating the khals including Outfal Betna and Marichap River under O&M Division-2, BWDB, Satkhira. He highlighted that Brick field is one of the obstacles for proper water management in the polder that is possible to eradicate during re-excavation of outfall Betna/ Marichap River. This would not be difficult- WMAs are enough for eradicating the obstacles as they empowered through the signing ceremony. He also requested WMAs to communicate with BWDB for Illegal occupancy and damages or losses of water resource infrastructures in the polder. Mr. Khan also said to WMAs that door is open for you all the time, you must come to us. Problem will be solved. At last he announced to close the program with a vote of thanks.



6. CONCLUSION

This signing ceremony is one of the greatest successes of BGP in Satkhira. Everybody think that this will act as a milestone for the polder water management in the next coming years. Now WMAs are becoming self-sustaining organization and capable to hold O&M responsibilities of water resource management activities. They demonstrated their confidence, commitment, and ownership on the water resource management infrastructures through signing O&M agreements and taking over the responsibilities in presence of all the implementing partners, donor and media people. This is the important indicator to step forward of successful phasing out of BGP.
