**PREFACE**

The Blue Gold Program (BGP) is a priority initiative and a landmark development program in the coastal zone of Bangladesh with a vision focus on water management and agriculture. Initiated between 2012 and 2015, the program was funded by the governments of Bangladesh and the Netherlands and implemented by the Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB) and the Department of Agriculture Extension (DAE), two state-owned entities (SOEs) in its capacity as the primary of Bangladesh. BGP's focus is to improve the livelihoods of coastal zone farmers and to contribute to the national food security and nutrition goals.

The BGP has implemented a number of activities to improve the livelihoods of coastal zone farmers. The program has achieved significant results in the areas of water management, agricultural extension, and livelihoods. The program has also contributed to the national food security and nutrition goals.

- Improved water management: water control systems, improved irrigation and increased water use efficiency, improved water quality, improved water storage, and improved water distribution.
