#### **Day-1**

##### **A. Icebreaker**

The programme was started with informal activities. In formal inaugural session we explained the starting of the training. First all the participants introduced themselves. Responses from each participant were noted down on a separate sheet. This helped the facilitator to know the background of each participant. Then participants attended a pre test. It found question set is useful for pre test. All participants spent thirty-five minutes for this.

After the pre test, participants were asked to do a warm up exercise. We Katherine conducted this exercise. Participants were given a piece of paper and a pen. We Katherine distributed the pens. Each participant was given a piece of paper and a pen. Participants were asked to write the name of their first name. Then a piece of paper was on a rotating round. Participants passed the names to others around each other. After this exercise, participants were asked to introduce themselves. This exercise helped the participants to increase their confidence and ability. Few groups were formed among the participants for whole training period.

After ten minutes, some leaders composed a team. They were asked to discuss what they can do in a group on Blue Gold project. This helped the facilitator to know what the group can do. The session was interactive. Participants shared their views on meaning of Blue Gold. It explained the role of Blue Gold in the agriculture. The project was also discussed. The project was also discussed with respect to its objectives to increase the water as a valuable asset for food security and agricultural development.
