International Women's Day: International Women's Day is a worldwide event that celebrates women's achievements – from the political to the social – while calling for gender equality.

It has been observed since the early 1900s and is now recognized each year on March 8 March. It is not affiliated with any one group, but brings together governments, women's organizations, corporations and charities. The day is marked around the world with arts performances, talks, and rallies, networking events, conferences and marches in many countries around the world. It is a day when women are recognized for their achievements without regard to divisions, whether national, ethnic, linguistic, cultural, economic or political. International Women's Day first emerged from the activities of labour movements at the turn of the twentieth century in North America and across Europe.



For the past couple of years, women's rights have dominated the news, following a global reckoning on sexual misconduct rippling through industries. Following the outpouring of allegations against Harvey Weinstein and other prominent men in power (and Weinstein's [watershed trial](#)), the #MeToo movement gave a voice to women on the abuse and harassment they suffer in film, fashion, music, politics and art.
