PREFACE

The realization of the National Water Policy is a key step towards good governance in Bangladesh. In the absence of such a policy, much damage has already been done to the biodiversity and sustainability of the country. Many adverse and counter-productive activities have been carried out in lack of coordination, in uncoordinated programmes and use of water resources. For a water-dependent country like Bangladesh, this situation is highly detrimental to the overall development and the needs of its vulnerable people.

The National Water Policy aims towards the strategic objectives by bringing order and discipline to the regulation, management and use of water resources in Bangladesh. It clearly and well thought defines the vision of the policy and the "end state" which it seeks to achieve and will be used to frame the water resources of the country. It is a comprehensive, complete and equitable vision. It sets out the objectives of such a policy and provides the broad guidelines for achieving these objectives. The policy has successfully integrated internationally accepted water management practices, norms and standards, with the knowledge, social and economic needs of a developing country. The new strength of the policy, however, emerges from its developmental and democratic vision that gives every one the opportunity to take part in the use and sharing of water in an efficient, equitable and environmentally sustainable manner.

The publication of this Policy is with the hope that it will bring a new era of water resources management in the country. Following the objectives of the policy, sound policies, norms, standards, rules and regulations and concerted effort by all concerned agencies and the people in general, will help to implement the Policy in right manner. I hope the National Water Council will monitor its implementation with diligence and determination.
