PREFACE

The Blue Gold Program (BGP) is a poverty reduction and economic transformation program in the coastal region of Bangladesh with a central focus on water management and agriculture. Implemented between 2012 and 2021, the program was funded by the governments of Bangladesh and the Netherlands and supported by the Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB) and the Department of Agriculture Extension (DAE). The total estimated cost of BGP is 1.2 billion USD, with 500 million USD from the Dutch government and 700 million USD from the Bangladesh government.

The BGP has supported coastal farmers to diversify their agricultural production and increase their income. It has also helped to improve their access to credit and other services. The program has been successful in increasing the resilience of coastal farmers to climate change and other risks.
