### Introduction

Training on WMA Capacity Building and Catchment O&M Planning Process for of ToF course for Catchment Committee Facilitators on Sluice Catchment O&M planning process for WMA EC Members and O&M Sub Committee Members for Polder- 27/1&2 and 28/1&2 (selected) was organized at Khulna on Sep 1-5, 2019.



These are 3<sup>rd</sup> phased polders where WMA formation completed in last 1.5 years back. They did not receive any formal/informal training for water management & organizational capacity development. The Polder Teams experience and assessment is 3<sup>rd</sup> phased polders WMOs have lack of knowledge and understanding on the above issues. Considering that WMA EC committee members are included in this training course with O&M sub-committee members and accordingly revised the training contents and outline. The 1<sup>st</sup> 2 days was conducted organizational and water management issues and remaining 3 days on polder water management, process and practice on O&M plan preparation.

The objective of the training course was twofold:

1. To develop the capacity of the Water Management Association & O&M Sub Committee Members on organizational management and water management for agriculture production;
2. To develop capacity on preparation, implementation of Catchment O&M Planning Process at the WMA and Catchment level involving farmers, UP and WMO representatives.

#### Training participants

According to the schedule the training on WMA Capacity Building and Catchment O&M Planning process has been started on 1<sup>st</sup> Sep 2019. The first 2 days (28/9 and 29/9) were for WMA EC members and WMA EC members (total 28 participants) members were attended the training of the course.
