## Guideline for collecting information by using tablet through ODK system.

### Introduction:

In a human centric and social development program, it is very essential to regularly monitor and report on how many resources are used and what they do in our program. We know how many/much resources in our program, how many hours are spent in making progress towards our program objectives, and how many deliverables are produced in other words, we document program inputs, activities and outputs.

- **Inputs** include resources dedicated to or accounted by the program. Examples are money, staffs and staff time, volunteers and volunteer time, facilities, equipment, and supplies. For instance, inputs for a BMD formation include the hours of staff-time spent designing and delivering the program. Inputs also include constraints on the program, such as laws, regulations, and requirements for receipt of funding.
- **Activities** are what the program does with the inputs to fulfill its mission. Activities include the strategies, techniques, and types of treatment that comprise the methodology of program's deliverables/services. For instance, convincing community people about the Blue-Field Program is a program activity, as are training and motivating poor farmers to cultivate more agr products to eradicate poverty.
- **Outputs** are direct products of program activities and usually are measured in terms of the volume of work accomplished. For example, the numbers of sanitation training, numbers of trainings, how many agricultural extension/health distributed (seeds, ducklings, chickens), numbers of chicks reared and fed, how many fish released in fisheries. They are important because they are intended to lead to a desired benefit for target populations.
- **Outcomes** are benefits or changes for individuals or populations during or after
